At present, the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Culture, Sports and Tourism and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs provide scholarships for international students.

Eligibility	Scholars outside Korea who conduct comparative or case studies in the field of Korean studies or in Korea-related areas in the fields of the humanities or social sciences, or focus on research topics that are closely related to Korea and recognized as important new areas of study, and fall under one of the following 'Type A' or 'Type B' criteria
